Task: Plan the perfect robbery!

Situation: In English class today, you made a test. You are very worried that you will get a bad grade (=onvoldoende), so you have decided to steal the tests. This way, the teacher won't be able to grade the tests (=nakijken). Can you and your partner plan the perfect robbery?

Organisation:

Students communicate in pairs in a digital environment (Google Classroom, Meet, Skype etc). Student A invites student B to start the task. The teacher decides in which mode (audio, video or written chat) students perform the task and whether the conversation will be recorded and shared with the teacher.

Goals: You have finished the task successfully, when you have agreed on a plan for a robbery in which you 1) steal the keys and tests without being seen, 2) have the perfect alibi and 3) implicate (=verdacht maken) someone else.

Preparation: Each of you is given a picture of the classroom. This picture is taken from different angles and contains different information. So, to make a plan for your robbery, you will need to work together. **Do not show your picture to your partner!**

1. Study the classroom carefully:
 - Where does the teacher keep the keys / tests?
 - Where is the teacher likely to be?
 - Who might be able to see you, and from which angle?
2. Check that you know how to say *where* things are (using words like *under, in, on top of, etc*).

Task:

1. Neem contact op met je chatpartner. Maak tijdens jullie (chat)gesprek samen een plan voor jullie roof. Bedenk
 - Hoe en wanneer je ongezien de sleutel kunt stelen, en weer kunt terugleggen.
 - Hoe en wanneer je de toetsen kunt stelen.
 - Waar je de toetsen zolang het beste kunt bewaren.
 - Wie je bij jullie plan wil betrekken.
 - Hoe je jullie docent Engels het beste om de tuin kunt leiden.
2. Bedenk samen een alibi: waarom kunnen jullie absoluut niet de schuldige zijn?
3. Bedenk samen wie je verdacht kunt maken van de roof, en hoe je dat wilt doen (bv. door een toets in zijn/haar tas te stoppen).
